
About

The SCBOI Interactive Dashboard provides an instant visual representation of statewide maternal and birth outcomes metrics across payment, individual facility, and geographical characteristics. Users can filter, print, and share these data. By connecting the data to quality improvement information, the dashboard can be used as a tool to facilitate data-driven collaborative decisions and improve the clinical outcomes of delivery patients and babies in South Carolina.

How to Use the SCBOI Interactive Dashboard



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
Click Continue to the Dashboard.

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

In Available Reports, there are two options for launching the SCBOI Dashboard—Statewide and Hospitals.

Statewide is available to the public and does not require a login. This report provides statelevel information including maternal and newborn characteristics and quality measures. It includes characteristics such as plurality, parity, maternal age, race, and residence, as well as SCBOI outcome measures.

Click Launch Public Dashboard to explore the Statewide report.

NOTE: On the first launch of the Public Dashboard, you will see this popup with copyright information, Terms of Use for the presented data and materials, and other terms and conditions related to accessing the dashboard.



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To agree to the presented Terms and Conditions. click the checkbox **area** at the bottom of the popup window.

After clicking the checkbox, the Submit button will be enabled. Click **Submit** to explore the statewide report.

The Hospitals option generates a similar report at the individual hospital level. These are only available to authorized users who have filled out a registration form and created a verified account. (See the FAQs for additional access information.)

Click Login to enter credentials and view an individual hospital's report.




Using the Dashboard: The Report Tabs

Launching either the Statewide or the Hospitals report opens the **Maternal Health** tab, which as seen in the navigation bar, is one of five available report views. (The example shown here is from the Statewide report window. The Hospital version differs slightly because it includes a login/ logout option.)

Each of the five tabs generates one of two types of report layouts—**POPULATION** or **OUTCOMES**.





8. Printing a Report

The SCBOI Dashboard uses your web browser to prepare a document for printing.

For most browsers, clicking on the print icon will open a window that shows a preview of the document to be printed. The elements currently visible on the screen will be arranged to fit on the page, and you may be prompted to save the document as a PDF or to send directly to a printer (depending on your browser settings).





9. Exporting Charts

To export a chart for later viewing, click the **export chart button**.

This will open your browser's download pop-up window and allow

you to save an HTML file that contains the chart image in PNG format, along with information about your filter choices. To open the downloaded file, click it, and the HTML document will open in your default browser.

NOTE: Saving the image by right-clicking and choosing "save image" will not include information about the filters that were applied to the visualization.




